



ILTA KM Peer-to-Peer Group FAQs

- What is the ILTA KM peer-to-peer group?

It is a group of KM practitioners in law firms, corporate/government law departments, and other law-related organizations. The goal of the group is to provide an efficient way to meet peers, exchange ideas, and generally further KM development in law-related organizations.

- What are the benefits of being a member of ILTA KM?

While you don't need to "join" to read public materials on ILTA site, members can participate in KM-focused listservs, webinars, and conferences etc. and thereby get the benefits of networking with their counterparts in other organizations.

- Why would I join ILTA KM group if all I do is KM and I'm in a region that does have a working law firm KM group?

One of the benefits of membership is the ability to participate in the listserv. You can also meet and exchange ideas with peers outside of your region.

- Who can join the group?

Anyone whose organization is an ILTA member; if your organization is not a member, go to ILTA site (www.iltanet.org) for information on how to apply.

- How much does it cost to join ILTA?

Annual dues are tiered by firm size: \$500 <50 attorneys; \$700 for 50-250 attorneys; \$900 for >250 attorneys. Check the ILTA site (www.iltanet.org) to determine whether firm or organization is already a member.

- How do I join?

Go to www.iltanet.org and click on the Join ILTA link and follow the directions.
